AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE BIRCH TREE/ELMORE LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 20, 1999 A BALLOT PROPOSITION APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF SAID LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF THREE YEARS. ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 27.20.200 AND 27.30.290.

WHEREAS THE Birch Tree/Elmore Limited Road Service Area was created by Anchorage Ordinance 81-117; and

WHEREAS a showing of interest in continuing said limited road service beyond December 31, 1999 has been made by persons residing in said limited road service area; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Birch Tree/Elmore Limited Road Service Area at the regular Municipal election on April 20, 1999:

CONTINUATION OF THE  
BIRCH TREE/ELMORE LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA

Shall the existence of the Birch Tree/Elmore Limited Road Service area be continued for an additional period of three (3) years after December 31, 1999 until December 31, 2002?

4 Section 2. That Section 27.20.320 of the Anchorage Municipal  
5 Code is hereby amended to read as follows:  
6

7 Pursuant to section 27.10.050, there is established a  
8 board of supervisors to administer the Birch Tree/Elmore  
9 Limited Road Service Area. The board shall consist of five  
10 members elected for staggered terms. [THE SERVICE AREA WILL  
11 EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 1999, UNLESS IT IS EXTENDED BY VOTE IN  
12 THE AREA AFFECTED AT THE REGULAR ELECTION OF APRIL 1999.]  
13

14 Section 3. That Section 27.30.290 of the Anchorage Municipal  
15 Code is hereby amended to read as follows:  
16

17 There is a limited road service area within the  
18 municipality known as the Birch Tree/Elmore Limited Road  
19 Service Area to provide limited road maintenance and repair to  
20 the area described on the map located in Section 27.30.700.  
21

22 Limited road maintenance and repair within the service  
23 area shall commence on January 2, 1982 and shall end on  
24 December 31, [1999] 2002 unless the service area is extended  
25 by an affirmative vote in the area affected at the regular  
26 election of [April 1999] April 2002. The mill rate for the  
27 service area shall not exceed 1.5 mills in any calendar year.

29

30 Section 4. Except for Section 3, this ordinance shall become  
31 effective upon passage and approval. Section 3 and the  
32 proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon  
33 certification of the regular election on the proposition  
34 called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is  
35 approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the  
36 proposition.
