AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE TALUS WEST LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD APRIL 20, 1999. A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO INCREASE THE TALUS WEST LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA MILL LEVY.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Talus West Limited Road Service Area established by Anchorage Municipal Code Section 27.30.200 at the regular Municipal election to be held April 20, 1999:

Proposition

TALUS WEST LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA.
MILL RATE INCREASE OF ONE-HALF (0.5) MILL

Shall the mill rate for the Talus West Limited Road Service Area be increased one-half (0.5) mill effective retroactively for the tax year beginning January 1, 1999 to provide additional funds for road maintenance and repairs?

A "Yes" vote authorizes the Assembly to levy and the Municipality to collect an additional one-half (0.5) mill on taxable property in the Talus West Limited Road Service Area effective for the tax year beginning January 1, 1999. Approval of this additional one-half (0.5) mill will increase the maximum mill rate for this service area's functions up to and including 1.3 mills.

Section 2 Anchorage Municipal Code Section 27.30.200 is amended to read as follows:

27.30.200 Talus West Limited Road Service Area.


There is an established limited road service area within the Municipality known as the Talus West Limited Road Service Area (TWLRSA) as depicted on the map located in Section 27.30.700. The Talus West Limited Road Service Area shall provide limited road maintenance within the service area commencing on January 1, 1980, and ceasing December 31, 2000, unless extended by an affirmative vote in the area affected at the regular election of April 2000. The mill rate shall not exceed [0.8] 1.3 mills in any calendar year.

Section 3: Section 2. of this ordinance shall become effective retroactively on January 1, 1999, and the mill rate increase contained in the Proposition set forth in Section 1. shall become effective according to its terms upon certification of the April 20, 1999 Municipal election if, but only if, the Proposition contained in Section 1. of this ordinance is approved by a majority of the qualified voters in the Talus West Limited Road Service Area voting on the Proposition. All other Sections of this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval.
