25 votes cast for the office of mayor , the assembly, within three weeks from the date
26 of certification of the election, shall hold a run-off election between the two
27 candidates receiving the highest number of votes for the office.

31 **Section 2.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the
32 Assembly and the proposition contained in Section 1. of this ordinance shall become effective as
33 an amendment to the Anchorage Municipal Charter upon certification of the regular election to be
34 held April 20, 1999 if, but only if, it is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the
35 proposition.
