ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.30.141, RECOGNIZED HOLIDAYS WITH
PAY, TO INCLUDE MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. DAY AS A PAID MUNICIPAL HOLIDAY

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That Anchorage Municipal Code Section 3.30.141, Recognized holidays with pay, is amended to read as follows:

3.30.141 Recognized holidays with pay.

The following days will be recognized as holidays with pay for all employees in regular full-time and regular part-time positions.

New Year's Day.

Martin Luther King Jr. Day (third Monday in January).

Washington's Birthday (third Monday in February).

[SEWARD'S DAY (LAST MONDAY IN MARCH).]

Memorial Day (last Monday in May).

Independence Day.

Labor Day.

Veterans Day (November 11).

Thanksgiving Day.

The day after Thanksgiving.

Christmas Day.

One personal holiday.

Section 2: That this ordinance is effective immediately upon passage and approval
