AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ENACTING A NEW
SECTION 2.20.100 TO PROHIBIT THE EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC FUNDS APPROPRIATED
BY THE ASSEMBLY TO LOBBY THE ASSEMBLY OR SCHOOL BOARD.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended by enacting a new section 2.20.100 to
read as follows:

2.20.100 Lobbying

A. No Municipal official or employee, agency, department, enterprise activity including a utility,
board, commission or other municipal body and no nonprofit organization receiving
municipal grants may knowingly obligate or expend public funds appropriated by the
Assembly to compensate or provide anything of value to any person in exchange for
lobbying the Assembly or School Board on any legislative or administrative matter or action.

1. This section does not apply to the established, regular compensation of a municipal
official or employee or an officer, director or employee of a non-profit organization
receiving municipal grants for the performance of duties and responsibilities within the
scope of their employment which may include lobbying the Assembly, provided such
lobbying does not constitute the primary or major portion of the official's or employee's
assigned duties and responsibilities.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval
by the Assembly.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING
ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 15.55.050 AND 15.65.030 TO EXTEND
THE EXPIRATION OF PERMITS FOR WATER WELL CONSTRUCTION AND ON-
SITE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SYSTEM CONSTRUCTION FROM ONE YEAR TO
TWO YEARS

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

Section 1: That AMC 15.55.050A.3. is amended to read as follows:

3. A permit for a domestic water system shall expire two [ONE] years from
the date of issuance.

Section 2: That AMC 15.65.030 is amended to add the following:

J. Expiration of permit. A permit for an on-site wastewater disposal
system shall expire two years from the date of issuance.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and
approval.
