COMMISSION.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That section 14. of Anchorage Ordinance No. 98-187 is repealed

Section 2: That sections 3., 5., 6., 7., and 9. of Anchorage Ordinance No. 98-187 shall
become effective December 15, 1999.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and
approval by the Assembly.

SUBJECT: Ordinance Delaying for Six Months the Effective Dates of Provisions Enacting Safety-Related Ordinances Involving Taxicabs Which Otherwise Would Become Effective in June of 1999

As you requested, attached is an ordinance which would delay for six months the effective dates of provisions enacting safety-related ordinances involving taxicab equipment and training and testing of taxicab dispatchers which would otherwise become effective on June 13, 1999. Passage of this ordinance would delay the effective date of these provisions to December 15, 1999. The affected provisions are those requiring:

Radio Transmission ID through Dispatch Service

Silent Alarm System

Requirement of Safety Shield, Surveillance System, or Global Positioning System

Capability

Caller ID

Dispatcher and Telephone Assistant Drug and Alcohol Testing

Standardized Training and Certification Programs for Dispatchers
