AN ORDINANCE CONTINUING OR REESTABLISHING THE PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY
COMMISSION.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Code Section 4.05.150, the Public Safety Advisory Commission shall be and is hereby continued and reestablished as set forth in the Anchorage Municipal Code section 4.60.270 for an additional period of three (3) years from and after April 30, 1999. During the period of time from and after April 30, 1999 until the effective date of this ordinance, all actions of the following boards and commissions, all appointments thereto and all unexpired terms of their members shall continue to be and constitute the actions of, appointments to and the unexpired terms of their members, as the case may be, as if it had not been terminated by operation of law.

Section 2. Nothing in this ordinance shall be taken as or constitute any approval, ratification or implementation of or ruling or action on any action of any board or commission listed in Section 1. of this ordinance by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
