AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING
ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 9.26.020, REDUCING THE MAXIMUM
SPEED LIMIT ON CERTAIN STREETS, AS DETERMINED BY THE TRAFFIC
ENGINEER

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That AMC 9.26.020 is amended to read as follows:

Except when a special hazard exists that requires lower speed for
compliance with section 9.26.010, the limits specified in this section or established as
authorized in this chapter shall be maximum lawful speeds, and no person may drive a
vehicle at a speed in excess of such maximum speed limits:

A. Fifteen miles per hour in any alley or public parking lot.

B. Less than twenty-five miles per hour on streets of less than 600
feet in total length, if determined to be warranted by the traffic
engineer.

C.[B] Twenty-five miles per hour on all streets except as otherwise
posted by the traffic engineer.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon
passage and approval.
