Section 1:

That AMC 11.30.070 is amended to read as follows:

11.30.070

Duty to serve public.

A. - C. No change

*D.

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY CHAUFFEUR OR PASSENGER IN A
REGULATED VEHICLE TO SMOKE ANY CIGAR, PIPE, OR CIGARETTE
OR TO BURN TOBACCO OR ANY OTHER MATERIAL IN SUCH
VEHICLES.†

NO CHAUFFEUR MAY EAT OR DRINK IN A REGULATED VEHICLE
WHILE A PASSENGER IS IN THE VEHICLE.]

A CHAUFFEUR OF A REGULATED VEHICLE MAY PLAY AN AUDIO
ENTERTAINMENT DEVICE ONLY IF ALL PASSENGERS DO NOT
OBJECT.]
