### AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY FORMALLY ADOPTING THE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ANCHORAGE BOWL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

WHEREAS, Section 12,01 of the Home Rule Charter requires the Assembly by ordinance to adopt and implement, and from time to time modify, a comprehensive plan setting forth goals, objectives, and policies governing the future development of the Municipality: and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Plan is essential for the orderly development of Anchorage and for maintaining the quality of life which residents of Anchorage expect and deserve: and

WHEREAS, following an open public process, the Planning and Zoning Commission on January 21, 1999, formally adopted and recommended for enactment by the Assembly revised goals and objectives for the Anchorage Bowl Comprehensive Development Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly ordains:

Section 1: AMC 21.05.025 is repealed and re-enacted to read as follows

### 21.05.025 Goals and Objectives

A. The goals and objectives of the Comprehensive Plan are those set forth in the Anchorage Bowl Comprehensive Plan Anchorage 2020 Goals and Objectives as approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission on January 21, 1999.

B. The specific policies, standards, and goals of the adopted Turnagain Arm, Eagle River-Chugiak-Eklutna and Anchorage Bowl comprehensive plans shall be controlling where in conflict with the goals of the comprehensive development plan.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and approval.

Subject: Comp Plan - Goals and Objectives

Last year, under the leadership of Department of Community Planning and Development, a diverse group of hundreds of local citizens met together and prepared draft goals and objectives for a new Anchorage Bowl Comprehensive Development Plan. Their efforts resulted in a consensus draft which was presented to and approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission on January 21, 1999.

Consistent with the Administration's goal of completing the second phase of the Anchorage
Bowl Comprehensive Development Plan by the end of 1999, the draft Goals and
Objectives are presented to the Assembly for enactment at this time. This ordinance
would formally enact the draft Goals and Objectives as approved by the Planning and
Zoning Commission earlier this year and would provide a solid foundation and policy
direction for completion of the second phase of the Plan during the next five months.

Like other ordinances, this ordinance requires a public hearing of the Assembly and can
be amended by the Assembly at the request of its members or the Mayor before
enactment. Enactment of this ordinance will enable the Municipality to complete the
second phase of the Plan under the Mayor's timetable by allowing staff and citizen work
groups to utilize the work product of hundreds of involved citizens which has already been
approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission.
