AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE ("AMC") SUBSECTION 9.65.020A. BY REMOVING THE REQUIREMENT THAT RESIDENTIAL PARKING ZONES ONLY BE CREATED WHERE THE ANCHORAGE PARKING AUTHORITY "HAS CODE ENFORCEMENT POWERS" AND AMENDING AMC SECTIONS 9.30.240, 9.30.250, 9.30.260, AND 9.30.310 TO CHANGE ANY REFERENCE TO "PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" TO "POLICE OFFICER"

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

Section 1: Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 9.65.020A. is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.65.020 Petition for Establishment of Residential Parking Zone

A. [WHERE] T[t]he parking authority [HAS ENFORCEMENT POWERS, IT] shall establish and administer residential parking programs in residential parking zones as provided by this chapter.

Section 2: Anchorage Municipal Code section 9.30.240 is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.30.240 Enforcement Officers

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, the provisions of chapters 9.30, 9.32 and 9.34 may be enforced by any police officer [, DESIGNATED POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEE OR PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER], as defined in section 9.04.010[, AND BY ANY STATE OR MUNICIPAL FIRE INSPECTOR WITH RESPECT TO MARKED FIRE LANES].

Section 3: Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 9.30.250A. is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.30.250 Notice of Violation

A. A vehicle parked, stopped or standing in violation of a provision of chapter 9.30, 9.32 or 9.34 is a public nuisance. Upon discovery of a vehicle parked, stopped or standing in violation of a provision of chapter 9.30, 9.32 or 9.34, a police officer [PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER] shall issue a notice of violation as authorized by section 9.30.240, and deliver it to the operator of the vehicle or affix it to the vehicle if it is unattended at the time of issuance. The notice of violation shall identify the vehicle, the nature of the violation and the means of resolving it.

<u>Section 4:</u> Anchorage Municipal Code subsections 9.30.260A. through C. inclusive are hereby amended to read as follows:

9.30.260 Impoundment of Improperly Parked Vehicle as Public Nuisance

- A. No person shall allow, maintain or permit a public nuisance to exist.
- B. A vehicle which has been the object of four or more unresolved citations for parking, stopping or standing in violation of this title is a public nuisance subject to abatement by immediate impoundment by a police officer [PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER]. This section shall not affect the independent authority of a police officer to impound a vehicle as provided in section 9.30.020.
- C. A police officer [PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER] is authorized to impound a vehicle which is found to be parked, stopped or standing in violation of any section of chapters 9.30, 9.32 or 9.34 when the traffic engineer has determined that such a violation threatens the public health, safety or welfare and therefore justifies immediate impoundment.

<u>Section 5:</u> The Anchorage Municipal Code section 9.30.310 is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.30.310 Authority to Void Parking Violation Notice

- A. If the parking authority determines that a notice of parking violation has been improperly issued, it may rescind that notice by writing the word "void" on its face. A record shall be maintained for all actions taken pursuant to this section. The parking authority may invoke this section upon finding that one of the following conditions existed at the time of the notice was issued:
 - 1.[A.] The parking meter was broken or malfunctioning at the time of the violation.
 - 2.[B.] The vehicle bore a handicapped parking notice issued pursuant to section 9.30.235.
 - 3.[C.] The vehicle had a convention visitor notice issued pursuant to section 9.30.320.
 - 4.[D.] The parking violation notice was improperly executed by the <u>police</u> officer [PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER].
 - 5.[E.] Other good cause.

<u>Section 6:</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
