AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 3.75.030 AND 3.75.060, REQUIRING THE DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN MATERIALS TO NEW EMPLOYEES REGARDING EXERCISE OF FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHTS AND ELIMINATING A TECHNICAL REFERENCE TO THE ANCHORAGE TELEPHONE UTILITY

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That Anchorage Municipal Code Section 3.75.030 D. is amended to read as follows:

3.75.030 Prohibited actions by municipality.

D. The municipality shall post notices and use other appropriate means to inform employees of their protections and obligations under section 3.75.010 through 3.75.070. The Director of Employee Relations shall ensure that each new municipal employee, within ~~thirty~~^{seven} days of hire, receives a copy of a handout explaining the First Amendment rights of municipal employees as required under the settlement agreement in *Government Hill Community Council v. Municipality of Anchorage*, (3 AN 97-4549 CI).

Section 2: That Anchorage Municipal Code Section 3.75.060 B. is amended to read as follows:

3.75.060 Relationship of chapter to other laws. [; APPLICABILITY TO ANCHORAGE TELEPHONE UTILITY]

[B. THIS CHAPTER SHALL APPLY TO THE ANCHORAGE TELEPHONE UTILITY.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval
