A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND  
HONORING SAMUEL G. CORNELL FOR HIS 21 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, on May 4, 1977, Samuel G. Cornell began his initial employment with the  
Department of Health and Human Services, and in 1986 transferred to the Anchorage Equal Rights  
Commission as an investigator; and

WHEREAS, during his employment with the Municipality of Anchorage, he successfully  
completed professional training courses with the International City Management Association,  
Grantsmanship Courses, and the American Management Association receiving full credits upon  
completion; and

WHEREAS, in 1983, he served, in distinction, as Acting Director of the Department of Social  
Services and in 1991 and 1998 as acting director of the Anchorage Equal Rights Commission; and

WHEREAS, as an investigator, he has represented the Municipality of Anchorage and the  
Anchorage Equal Rights Commission in well over 100 work site presentations throughout the City in  
an effort to bring about awareness and sensitivity for the wide cultural diversity represented in the  
Municipality of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, as an investigator, he has conducted over 600 investigations of discrimination in  
his 11 years with the AERC.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves that

**SAMUEL G. CORNELL**

is recognized for his 21 years of service to the Municipality of Anchorage and the citizens of  
Anchorage.
