A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING SAM OLIVERI AS A "CITY HERO"

WHEREAS, on Monday, December 14, 1998, in the cafeteria of Gladys Wood Elementary School, an orange wedge caught in the windpipe of eight year-old Mark Johnson and stopped his breathing; and

WHEREAS, Mark tried unsuccessfully to dislodge the orange wedge by putting a couple of fingers into his mouth to grab the orange; and

WHEREAS, school custodian Sam Oliveri, who was on lunch duty at the time of the incident, noticed that Mark was choking and reacted on reflex by lifting Mark, putting his arms at his sides, then putting his own arms around Mark's torso and successfully applying the Heimlich maneuver - a maneuver he had seen several times on an instructional video in first aid training provided by the Anchorage School District; and

WHEREAS, after the incident Mark said: "I thought I was going to die" - however, the fast-acting efforts of Mr. Oliveri saved Mark's life; and
