28 Section 1. [1st alternate] That based on the findings above set forth, the Anchorage Municipal  
29 Assembly hereby protests the transfer of ownership of the beverage dispensary license for Debco, Inc., d/b/a  
30 The Irish Setter, located at 1911 East Fifth Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska.

32 Section 1. [2d alternate] That based on the findings above set forth, the Anchorage Municipal  
33 Assembly hereby protests the transfer of ownership of the beverage dispensary license for Debco, Inc., d/b/a  
34 The Irish Setter, located at 1911 East Fifth Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska, unless the following conditions are  
35 made permanent conditions of the licenses:

**Section 1. [3rd alternate]** The Anchorage Assembly waives protest of the transfer of ownership of the beverage dispensary license for Debco, Inc., d/b/a The Irish Setter, located at 1911 East Fifth Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska.

**Section 2.** The Municipal Attorney is directed to take appropriate steps to implement and/or present this resolution to the Alcohol Beverage Control Board.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.
