A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND
HONORING FIRE INSPECTOR DONALD E. BARLOW FOR HIS 27 YEARS OF
SERVICE WITH THE ANCHORAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, on June 13, 1971, Donald E. Barlow began his employment with the
former City of Anchorage working as a firefighter trainee in the Anchorage Fire
Department; and

WHEREAS, during his 27 year career with the Anchorage Fire Department, he held
various positions in the Fire Prevention Division which included Fire Inspector/Investigator,
Deputy Fire Marshall (in charge of code enforcement) and, ultimately, he received a
promotion to Battalion Chief; and

WHEREAS, as Fire Inspector he was often on camera or radio responding to fire
emergencies from the scene of the fire, becoming the Department's spokesman and voice
of comfort to many people in the community; and

WHEREAS, Donald E. Barlow has demonstrated his dedication to serving the
people of Anchorage both on and off the job, and has been a highly respected voice for
the fire prevention education and awareness programs.
