A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND THANKING
KATHLEEN PLUNKETT FOR HER SERVICE AS CHAIR OF THE FEDERATION OF COMMUNITY

WHEREAS, in January 1997, Kathleen Plunkett was elected as Chair of the Federation of
Community Councils; and

Obtained seats on the Advisory Panel for the Anchorage Metropolitan Area
Transportation System;
