THE EAST HIGH SCHOOL MUSIC DEPARTMENT FOR BEING SELECTED AS A GRAMMY  
SIGNATURE SCHOOLS GOLD RECIPIENT

WHEREAS, the National Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences (NARAS) Foundation, in  
conjunction with the 41<sup>st</sup> GRAMMY Awards, recently conducted its first annual Signature Schools  
Program; and

WHEREAS, last September, the NARAS Foundation mailed surveys to more than 14,000 high  
schools across the nation requesting information about each school's music program, and further  
requesting support documentation such as recordings of school concerts, sample concert programs,  
music curriculum and repertoire; and

WHEREAS, a panel of top music educators and professionals evaluated the materials and  
selected 250 high schools meeting Signature School status; and

WHEREAS, East High School was not only selected as one of the 250 Signature Schools, but it  
was one of only sixteen schools selected as a GRAMMY Signature Schools Gold recipient.
