A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND
HONORING GAIL KROTKE FOR HER 32 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OF
ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, in 1967, Gail Krotke began her initial employment with the Municipality of Anchorage working at Anchorage Telephone Utility/Utility Customer Service (UCS) at City Hall; and

WHEREAS, for the next 32 years, Gail worked as an Office Associate (Lead), Senior Office Assistant and Customer Service Representative with UCS, Anchorage Water Utility (AWU), and later, Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU), serving under four mayors and eight AWWU General Managers. During that time, she went through implementation of computerized billings from manual billings, and a billing conversion in 1987 separating AWWU billings from combined Municipal utility billings; she organized Girdwood billings by legal description where all others are by their service address; and she organized Eagle River billings from legal description to address, and handled close to 80,000 service orders.


