A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND THANKING

District and Jill was selected to head ASD's Community Education Department - a department which has  
grown over the years to include community schools, community services, community resources, and  
school business partnership; and

WHEREAS, Jill has been a leader through the years serving as Alaska Recreation & Parks  
Association Secretary (1978) and President (1979, 1995); Alaska Association of Community Education  
Regional Board Member (1982), President (1988), Legislative Chair (1989 - 1999); National Community  
Education Association Region 8 Board Representative (1991 - 1994); and this year she was elected  
President of the National Community Education Association; and

WHEREAS, over the years, Jill has served with many community organizations, to include the  
Healthy Futures Project, Anchorage Promises, Anchorage KidsPlace Project, Kids Day, Anchorage  
Association of Volunteer Administrators, and Alaska Recreation & Parks Association; and

WHEREAS, Jill recently accepted the position of Associate Director of the National Center for  
Community Education in Flint Michigan.
