A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING SENATE BILL 10 RELATING TO THE UNDERGROUNDING OF UTILITIES

WHEREAS, SB 10, sponsored by State Senator Donley, has been introduced before the State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, SB 10 provides that

A municipality with a population over 100,000 must spend at least one percent (1%) of the utility's annual gross revenue from customers within the municipality to place existing overhead utility distribution lines underground; and

A utility that is implementing a program to place existing overhead utility distribution lines underground may amend its rates for service to enable the utility to recover the full actual cost of placing the lines underground.

WHEREAS, within the guidelines of AMC Title 21, the Municipality currently undergrounds new projects, and the recent changes to AMC Title 24, which reimburses utilities for relocation projects when a road or alley is being upgraded, will facilitate undergrounding within the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, though the Municipality is taking positive steps to underground existing utilities, SB 10 will even further facilitate undergrounding within the Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves

Section 1: That the Assembly supports Senate Bill 10.

Section 2 That, upon passage, a copy of this resolution be forwarded by the Municipal

Clerk to the State Legislature.

In determining the annual gross revenue under this subsection, only revenue derived from the utility's distribution lines in the municipality shall be considered.
