A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 1999 ACTION PLAN OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE 1995-2000 HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CONSOLIDATED PLAN, WHICH CONSTITUTES THE APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM GRANT AND THE EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has conducted extensive research and analysis to compile the *1995-2000 Municipality of Anchorage Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan*, which is the basis for a comprehensive approach to address the housing and community development needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the *1999 Housing and Community Development Action Plan* comprises the Municipality's statement to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development of the activities which the Municipality has adopted to pursue to address the needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the activities identified in the *1999 Action Plan* will utilize 1999 annual entitlements of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and Home Investment Partnership Grant (HOME), and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG); and

WHEREAS, throughout the development of the *1999 Action Plan*, the Municipality of Anchorage encouraged and solicited comments and concerns of residents, neighborhoods, community councils, not-for-profit organizations, businesses, social service providers, and other local and state governments department and agencies; and

WHEREAS, public testimony on the *1999 Action Plan* was invited before the Housing & Neighborhood Development Commission on Wednesday, March 10, 1999, and written comments were invited from March 1 to March 31, 1999; and

2 WHEREAS, the *1999 Action Plan* has been endorsed by resolution of the
3 Housing & Neighborhood Development Commission;

5 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly Resolves
6

7 Section 1. The Assembly adopts the *1999 Action Plan* of the *1995-2000*
8 *Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan* as the general basis
9 for a comprehensive approach to address the housing and community
10 development needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods. The plan
11 serves the following functions:

- 13 A. To establish an ongoing planning and decision making process to
14 enable the Municipality to evaluate the needs of its residents and
15 neighborhoods; and
16 B To outline the activities the Municipality intends to undertake to
17 address said needs; and
18 C. To provide for uninterrupted flow of annual CDBG and HOME
19 entitlement grants to the Municipality; and
20 D To provide the basis for appropriation of the grant funds by the
21 Assembly to accomplish said activities.

23 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage
24 and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
