A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY EXPRESSING
APPRECIATION TO MARY A. LEE FOR HER DEDICATION AND SERVICE TO THE PEOPLE
OF ANCHORAGE UPON HER RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, Mary A. Lee, Public Health Nurse and HIV Counselor within the Community Health Services Division, Department of Health and Human Services, has dedicated over 43 years to improving the public health of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Lee has been an advocate for nursing since her early days as a public health nurse during the territorial days of Alaska, and as a school nurse for the Greater Anchorage Area Borough while her children were growing up; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Lee has been instrumental in improving the health care delivery to the people of Anchorage through her extensive background and knowledge in areas of public health nursing, which include tuberculosis control, immunizations, maternal child health, sexually transmitted diseases, HIV infection and, particularly, her work with individuals who are marginalized in society; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Lee has created an effective and innovative off-site program in conjunction with other community agencies to provide HIV testing, counseling and prevention education to high risk individuals who do not access traditional health care settings; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Lee, who is respected for her high professional ethics, dedication, caring, courage, and compassion, has received multiple awards and recognition for her work, including Employee of the Month for the Department of Health & Human Services in 1990 and again in 1993, Employee of the Year Award for Anchorage in 1993, Outstanding Prevention Effort in Mental Health in 1993, and she was nominated as a semi-finalist in the 1994 John F. Kennedy School of Government Innovative Programs at Harvard University.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:


That the Assembly expresses appreciation to
