ANCHORAGE. ALASKA **AR NO. 99-** 138

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE 10 ADOPTION OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME'S PLAN FOR 11 THE FISH LADDER AT CHESTER CREEK

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage's fish ladder at Chester Creek and Westchester 15 Lagoon is currently a non-functional fish ladder; and

WHEREAS, the railroad culverts at Chester Creek and the Alaska Railroad are an 18 obstruction to the passage of fish; and

WHEREAS, no functional fish ladder can be constructed without first addressing the railroad 21 culverts ;and

WHEREAS, there are three fish ladder proposals being offered by the following agencies-24 the United States Fish & Wildlife Service, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and the State of 25 Alaska, Department of Fish and Game; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality should support the fish ladder and resolution of the railroad 28 culvert problems that are most favorable to the Municipality, its residents and the fish populations 29 that reside or spawn in Chester Creek; and

WHEREAS, the State's plan bypasses the railroad culverts by constructing a flume from 32 | Westchester Lagoon's dike to and through the railroad bed in a large portal to a new all tide fish 33 ladder on the inlet side of the railroad tracks; which is similar to those used on the Tony Knowles 34 | Coastal Trail; and

WHEREAS, the State's plan has a pedestrian and bicycle path through the portal with the 37 | fish flume allowing access to the Inlet side of the railroad tracks and provides access to the Tony 38 Knowles Coastal Trail; and

WHEREAS, the State's plan provides for a handicapped-accessible aquarium-type viewing 41 area which can accommodate tourist buses and provide an educational viewing opportunity for 42 students and all residents of the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the State's plan provides three additional salmon viewing areas- in the portal 45 over the railing on the bike path, watching the salmon climb the fish ladder, and watching the 46 salmon mill around in Chester Creek at the base as they make the transition from salt to fresh water; and

WHEREAS, the State's plan provides for a small park on the inlet side of the railroad tracks between Chester Creek and the Sewer Lift Station which allows panoramic views of the inlet and surrounding mountain ranges and includes several amenities for picnics and provides a connection to the Coastal Trail; and

WHEREAS, the State's plan does not use the Municipality's Chester Creek Trust and the Municipality retains \$430,000 and the State requires no appropriation from the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the State's plan will use Federal funds to correct problems and will use those funds to secure more Federal funds to restore and enhance the Municipality's Chester Creek Greenbelt and acquire more land; and

WHEREAS, the State's plan requires no Municipal funds or obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

21 | Section 1: The Municipality supports the State of Alaska Department of Fish and Game's plan for a new all-tide fish ladder and railroad culvert bypass at Westchester Lagoon and the Alaska Railroad tracks.

Section 2: The Municipality supports a request to Senator Stevens for a \$1.71 million appropriation for the railroad culvert bypass and asks that the request be worded as to make that appropriation eligible for \$3.4 million appropriation in "206" matching funds.

Section 3: That the Municipality will request that the \$400,000 funding from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service be converted to a funding request for restoration and enhancement of Chester Creek and that the Federal appropriation eligible for \$860,000 in "206" matching funds be used for acquisition of Greenbelt and wetlands for Chester Creek.
