A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING ROBERT F.
"BOB" FUGE FOR HIS 28 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, Bob Fuge began working in the Public Works Department as a Maintenance Man II on July 9, 1971 receiving several promotions in a four-year period from Maintenance Man III to Maintenance Man V; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 1976, Bob left the Public Works Department after being promoted to Maintenance Foreman for the Sewer Utility, and received another promotion to General Foreman for the Water and Sewer Utility on April 3, 1978; and

WHEREAS, Bob's ultimate promotion was to Maintenance Superintendent with the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility on May 16, 1983 where he has been serving in this capacity for the last 16 years; and

WHEREAS, during Bob's tenure, he held the duties of Acting Manager of the Operations and Maintenance Division, and served on the JCC Negotiating Committee for the past two contract negotiations improving matters for the employees, and benefitting the Utility and the Municipality of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, Bob was responsible for reducing expenditures in time and money by providing his expertise to Municipal agencies such as Public Works, Fire Department, Solid Waste Services and the Port; and

WHEREAS, Bob's leadership skills were demonstrated when he took the lead with the State in researching new methods and technologies in excavation work, and when a flood threatened a railbed in the mid-1980's, Bob arranged to load AWWU's sewer jets on ARR flatbed cars to take to the site to flush out the culverts; and

WHEREAS, when a ditch collapsed in 1988, rapid-fire rescue efforts resulted in the saving of a life because of Bob's liaison efforts with the Anchorage Fire Department; and


WHEREAS, in addition to Bob's relationship with other Municipal agencies, he helped the City of Seldovia to locate and repair pipe leaks which had been causing a loss of 250,000 gallons of potable water a day.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves that:

ROBERT F. "BOB" FUGE

is recognized for his 28 years of service to the Municipality of Anchorage and the citizens of Anchorage upon his retirement.
