### A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING ELIZABETH "BETSY" KANAGO FOR HER 11 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, Elizabeth "Betsy" Kanago began her Municipal career in 1988 at the Department of Health and Human Services in the Planning Office; and

WHEREAS, she was part of the team that developed the Core Services Study initiated by the Health and Human Services Commission and went on to staff the Mayor's Blue Ribbon Panel on the Public Inebriate and Mayor's Task Force on the Homeless; and

WHEREAS, in 1991, she moved to the Division of Social Services as the first Manager of the Community Services Section created to establish and implement programs for the homeless and public inebriates that:

developed the Municipal Transitional Housing Program for families and single women;

developed the JumpStart Program for single men who needed assistance leaving shelters on the road to self sufficiency;

assisted in the establishment of the Emergency Shelter Program for families set up at the Mt. View Armory; and

WHEREAS, she has also worked on capital and operating budget preparation including renovation projects at the Clithroe Center and she served as the Department and Division representative for Operation StandDown for homeless veterans, Measles Hotline, the Americorps Program, Juvenile Justice Working Group, and grant monitor for the Anchorage Youth Court Program; and

WHEREAS, she has been the staff liaison to the Anchorage Senior Center and staff support to the Anchorage Women's Commission and Senior Citizens Advisory Commission which have produced outstanding studies on critical issues affecting these groups, and conducted the principal research on the community volunteer efforts of Alice Lawrence that led to her being the recipient of the President's Service Award in 1996.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves that:

is recognized for her 11 years of service to the Municipality of Anchorage and the citizens of Anchorage upon her retirement.
