For reading 1 2 Anchorage, Alaska 3 AR 99-165 4 5 A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE ANNUAL FFY99 ENTITLEMENT 6 GRANTS FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN 7 DEVELOPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-8 EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,268,000) FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG), NINE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE 9 10 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$965.000) FOR HOME INVESTMENT 11 PARTNERSHIPS (HOME) PROGRAM, AND EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$80,000) FOR EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANTS (ESG), TO THE FEDERAL 12 13 CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241). 14 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has submitted its 1999 Action 15 16 Plan of the 1995-2000 Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plan 17 to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, outlining the 18 program of activities to be undertaken with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Shelter Grant 19 20 (ESG) funds; and 21 22 WHEREAS, throughout the development of the 1999 Action Plan, the 23 Municipality of Anchorage actively sought participation of the public, and 24 25 WHEREAS, public testimony on the 1999 Action Plan was invited in person at the Housing and Neighborhood Development Commission on 26 27 Wednesday, March 10, 1999 and in writing for a period of 30 days; and 28 29 WHEREAS, the 1999 Action Plan has been endorsed by resolution of the 30 Housing and Neighborhood Development Commission. 31 32 WHEREAS, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly adopted the 1999 Action *Plan* on May 11, 1999. 33 34 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly Resolves: 35 36 37 Section 1. That the subject grants from the United States Department of 38 Housing and Urban Development for the FFY99 allocation of Community

Development Block Grant funds, in the amount of two million two hundred sixtyeight thousand dollars (\$2,268,000), the FFY99 allocation of HOME Investment Partnerships funds, in the amount of nine hundred sixty-five thousand dollars (\$965,000) and FFY99 allocation of Emergency Shelter Grant funds, in amount of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000), are hereby appropriated, subject to final HUD approval, to the Federal Categorical Grant Fund (241) for use in activities under the ESG, CDBG and HOME programs.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the allocation of said grant funds will be based on the
activities outlined in the attached Assembly Memorandum, and in the 1999
Action Plan of the 1995-2000 Consolidated Plan, which incorporates
Anchorage's Continuum of Care. Accounting information is outlined in the
attached Assembly Memorandum, Attachment A.

<u>Section 3.</u> This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and
approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
