A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVING THAT ALL ANCHORAGE ROAD PROJECTS PLANNED FOR CONSTRUCTION, REHABILITATION, REPAVING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS WILL INCLUDE FULL FUNDING FOR NEEDED ROADSIDE TRAIL, BICYCLE, SIDEWALK AND LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the people of Anchorage enjoy a high quality of life they want to maintain;

WHEREAS, Anchorage desires to become more of a winter city where pedestrians can walk safely in all seasons;

WHEREAS, on-road bicycle lanes, multipurpose pathways and separated, landscaped pedestrian facilities make Anchorage a more livable community and safer for our young people and elderly; and

WHEREAS, a number of road rehabilitation and repaving projects have not been funded to include sidewalk or pathway rehabilitation or repaving..

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves that:

All Anchorage road projects planned for construction, rehabilitation, repaving and safety improvements will include full funding for needed roadside trail, bicycle, sidewalk and landscaping improvements.
