A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE FOR THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AND THE ANCHORAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage (hereinafter MOA) and the Anchorage Police Department Employees Association (hereinafter APDEA) recognize that collective bargaining is the preferred method to achieve labor agreements; and

WHEREAS, the MOA and the APDEA have collectively bargained in good faith over the course of many months; and

WHEREAS, the MOA and the APDEA have reached agreement for a new five year Collective Bargaining Agreement between the parties; and

WHEREAS, the members of the APDEA overwhelming ratified the agreement on May 28. 1999; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code 3.70.130A stipulates that the agreement shall be presented to the Assembly for ratification in the same manner as a municipal ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly hereby ratifies the collective bargaining agreement between the MOA and the APDEA for the years 1999 - 2003.
