**A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE FOR THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL
OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY OF
ANCHORAGE AND THE ANCHORAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION.**

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage (hereinafter MOA) and the Anchorage Police
Department Employees Association (hereinafter APDEA) recognize that collective bargaining is the
preferred method to achieve labor agreements; and

WHEREAS, the MOA and the APDEA have collectively bargained in good faith over the course
of many months; and

WHEREAS, the MOA and the APDEA have reached agreement for a new five year Collective
Bargaining Agreement between the parties; and

WHEREAS, the members of the APDEA overwhelming ratified the agreement on May 28,
1999; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code 3.70.130A stipulates that the agreement shall be
presented to the Assembly for ratification in the same manner as a municipal ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly hereby ratifies the collective bargaining
agreement between the MOA and the APDEA for the years 1999 – 2003.
