WHEREAS, over the years, Joe was the driving force behind the Iditarod - from hustling the first purse in 1973 to helping seed the careers of countless mushers; and

WHEREAS, Joe also encouraged many foreign mushers and he is greatly responsible for the growth of long distance mushing in regions from Europe to South Africa; and

WHEREAS, when people said that mushing a dog team to the top of Mount McKinley could not be done, Joe and his dog team reached the summit in 1979; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to introduce more people to the thrill of dog mushing, Joe guided his first group of Iditarod Challengers - dog mushing tourists - from Knik to Nome in 1993; and

WHEREAS, Joe passed away on June 24, 1999, at his home in Knik, at the age of 82
