AR NO. 99- 218**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF A TAX REFUND AS A RESULT OF
MANIFEST CLERICAL ERROR ON REAL PROPERTY ACCOUNT 017-092-57**

WHEREAS, Randy L. Roosdett was the owner of record from December 15, 1995 through January 1, 1997 of the real property listed on account 017-092-57, and

WHEREAS, during this period of time the property was valued as developable, and

WHEREAS, the property was set aside by plat as an open space reserve and was not developable, and

WHEREAS, this overstatement constitutes a manifest clerical error, and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.45.500 (c) allows a governing body to correct manifest clerical errors at any time, and

WHEREAS, the amount of error for the tax years involved totals \$696.07 plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the sum of \$696.07 for principal plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment is hereby refunded.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
