A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIFTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50,250), FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF STATE TROOPERS, AND SIXTEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$16,750) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE 1999 ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA FUND (151) OPERATING BUDGET TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) FOR THIS METHAMPHETAMINE ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.

THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES

Section 1. That the sum of FIFTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50,250) is appropriated from the State of Alaska, Department of Public Safety, Division of State Troopers to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231).

Section 2. That the sum of SIXTEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$16,750) is appropriated from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area 1999 Operating Budget (151) to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval

Subject: Appropriation of the State of Alaska, Department of Public Safety, Division of State Troopers, Methamphetamine Enforcement Grant

The Municipality of Anchorage has received from the State of Alaska, Department of Public Safety, Division of State Troopers, a Methamphetamine enforcement grant in the amount of \$50,250. This grant, as governed by the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, Public Law 100-690, Title VI, Subtitle C, will be used to identify leads, investigate and make arrests associated with illegal activity involving methamphetamine production, sales and use.

A special condition of the grant is that the department provide matching funds. The total projected municipal cost is \$16,750.


