A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE NAMING THE PLAZA AT
Z.J. LOUSSAC LIBRARY THE "SOROPTIMIST PLAZA."

NOW, THEREFORE, The Anchorage Assembly Resolves:

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.97 of the Anchorage Municipal Code sets forward a policy and procedure for naming municipal facilities, and

WHEREAS, a Citizen Facility Naming Panel was selected by the Mayor and approved by the Assembly to name a future plaza to be constructed at the Z.J. Loussac Library; and


WHEREAS, the Citizen Facility Naming Panel has held a public meeting to solicit and evaluate names and recommends naming the plaza the "Soroptimist Plaza" in recognition of the fund raising activities of Soroptimist International of Anchorage for the future construction for this plaza.

Section 1. That this future plaza will serve as a replacement for the "Soroptimist Plaza" that was dismantled to make way for the Alaska Center for the Performing Arts.

Section 2. That the future plaza to be constructed with funds raised by Soroptimist International of Anchorage and to be located at the Z.J. Loussac Library adjacent to the ice water fountain between the base of the exterior stairs and the ice fountain itself, be named the "Soroptimist Plaza", and

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
