## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES

- Section 1. The conditional use permit for recreational site liquor license located on South Center Subdivision, Block 2, Lot 5A, is approved subject to the following conditions:
- 14 A notice of Zoning Action shall be filed with the District Recorders Office within 120 days of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board's approval of the license.
- All construction and uses shall substantially conform to the plans and narrative submitted.
- The use of the property by any person for the permitted purposes shall comply with all current and future federal, state and local laws and regulations including but not limited to laws and regulations pertaining to the sale, dispensing, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages and the storage, preparation, sale, service and consumption of food. The owner of the property, the licensee under the Alcoholic Beverage Control license and their officers, agents and employees shall not knowingly permit or negligently fail to prevent the occurrence of illegal activity on the property.

Section 2. Failure to comply with the conditions of this conditional use permit shall constitute
 grounds for its revocation.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.



Additional Conditions for Operating Recreational Site License, AS 4.11.210

The service of Beer and Wine will be limited to the partitioned Restaurant seating area located on the Mezzanine (as depicted on the attached exhibit A).

Service or consumption of beer and wine shall not be allowed on any other area of the mezzanine or on any of the first level floor area, (totaling about 76,000 square feet) including but not limited to the level one concession service, spectator seating, locker rooms, club rooms, and skating rinks.

No skates, hockey sticks or equipment may be worn into the Restaurant seating area.

Signage advertising alcoholic beverages, brand names or 'logos' will not be placed on the exterior of the building or within the building outside the Restaurant seating area.

Video arcade games will not be placed on the Mezzanine or within the Restaurant seating area.

All beverage service personnel and Arena management will receive Server awareness training provided by the Alcohol Beverage Control Board, and the Restaurant will be posted with ABC published advisory posters.


Alcoholic beverages will not be served during any high school game hosted at the Arena.

Minors unaccompanied by an adult parent or guardian will not be allowed in the Restaurant at any time

Alcoholic Beverages will be stored in locked coolers or equipment accessible only to authorized personnel.

  - 6:00 p.m. to midnight week days
    1:00 p.m. to midnight Saturday, Sunday and holidays.
- \* Food will be served as an amenity to beer and wine license.
