A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY URGING THE **ADMINISTRATION TO REINSTATE BUS ROUTE 90**

11 12 WHEREAS, during the 1999 budget savings and 2000 budget reduction exercise, 13 the Public Transportation Department deleted bus routes 90, 91, and 92 identifying these 14 routes as the lowest year-round routes in the People Mover System; and 15 16 WHEREAS, bus route 90 provides an integral service to our citizens: 17 18 Route 90 is the only route south of 36th Avenue between Arctic and Old 19 Seward: 20 Route 90 is the only bus service to 76th Avenue/Foxridge community which 21 is a growing neighborhood with 80 new condominium units just being 22 completed; 23 Route 90 also served the communities between C Street and Arctic (since 24 trying to cross Arctic is perilous after disembarking from bus route 9 on the 25 west side of Arctic); 26 Route 90 served as a commuter bus taking people to/from work (there were 27 a couple of runs in the morning and a couple of runs in the late afternoon to 28 accommodate workers); and 29 30 WHEREAS, the State just invested in new pullouts for the bus as part of the C 31 Street road expansion between Tudor and Raspberry. 32 33 WHEREAS, reinstatement of Route 90, even if just for the morning and evening 34 work commute, would be very beneficial. 35 36 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves. 37 38 Section 1: That the Administration is urged to reinstate People Mover bus service 39 on Route 90. 40 41 Section 2: That route 90 be included in the Public Transportation Department's 42 Year 2000 budget. 43 44 PASSED AND APPROVED by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly this dav 45 of _____, 1999. 46 47 [[] Chair 48 ATTEST 49 50
