A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF A TAX REFUND AS A RESULT OF MANIFEST CLERICAL ERROR ON REAL PROPERTY ACCOUNT 003-213-12

WHEREAS, Charles W. and Evalyn Ellis were the owners of record during the period that includes January 1, 1997 through January 1, 1998 of the real property listed on account 003-213-12, and

WHEREAS, during this period of time the finished basement living area was listed as 1,009 square feet, the first floor living area was listed as 1,705 square feet and the second floor living area was listed as 1,753 square feet. The total listed was 4,467 square feet, and

WHEREAS, the finished basement living area is in fact 1,241 square feet, the first floor living area 1,749 square feet, and there is no second floor living area. The total is 2,980 square feet, and

WHEREAS, this overstatement constitutes a manifest clerical error, and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.45.500 (c) allows a governing body to correct manifest clerical errors at any time, and

WHEREAS, the amount of error for the tax years involved totals \$1,601.30 plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,601.30 for principal plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment is hereby refunded.
