A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY REQUESTING THAT  
THE ADMINISTRATION TRANSFER \$32,000 FROM THE HOT SHOT ALLOCATION  
OF THE FEMA GRANT TO THE CHIPPER FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
COMPLETING THE 1999 SPRUCE SLASH CHIPPING

WHEREAS, the effect of Spruce Bark Beetles killed trees prompting receipt of a grant from  
the Federal Emergency Management Authority (FEMA) for the purpose of fire prevention in  
hazardous areas within the City; and

WHEREAS, these dead trees present a very high fire hazard within the city limits and it is  
urgent that they be removed in order to avoid disaster ; and

WHEREAS, although the removal of these trees was implemented during the Summer of  
1999, there are remaining Spruce Slash in need of chipping and removal from the Hillside.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves

Section 1: That the Administration is requested to transfer \$32,000 of the FEMA funds from  
the Hot Shot allocation to the Chipping allocation.

Section 2: That this resolution is effective immediately upon passage and approval
