**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF A TAX REFUND AS A RESULT OF  
MANIFEST CLERICAL ERROR ON REAL PROPERTY ACCOUNT 014-052-28**

WHEREAS, Gerry and Ernest N. Hunt and Michael N. Morgan were the owners of record on January 1, 1998 of the real property listed on account 014-052-28, and

WHEREAS, at this time the dwelling was listed as a house with a finished basement, and

WHEREAS, the dwelling is in fact a mobile home with a finished basement, and

WHEREAS, this misstatement of data constitutes a manifest clerical error, and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.45.500 (c) allows a governing body to correct manifest clerical errors at any time, and


WHEREAS, the amount of error for the tax year involved totals \$700.39 plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the sum of \$700.39 for principal plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment is hereby refunded.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
