**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF A TAX REFUND AS A RESULT OF  
MANIFEST CLERICAL ERROR ON REAL PROPERTY ACCOUNT 015-132-35**

WHEREAS, John R. Fischer was the owner of record during the period that includes  
January 1, 1992 through January 1, 1998 of the real property listed on account 015-132-35, and

WHEREAS, during this period of time the basement living area was listed as 1,710 square  
feet and the first floor living area was listed as 1,160 square feet—a total of 2,870 square feet, and

WHEREAS, during this period of time the basement living area was in fact 1,196 square  
feet and the first floor living area was also 1,196 square feet—a total of 2,392 square feet, and

WHEREAS, this 478 square foot overstatement constitutes a manifest clerical error, and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.45.500 (c) allows a governing body to correct manifest  
clerical errors at any time, and

WHEREAS, the amount of error for the tax years involved totals \$520.32 plus interest at  
8 percent per annum to the date of payment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the sum of \$520.32 for principal plus interest at 8 percent per annum to  
the date of payment is hereby refunded.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the  
Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
