Wallace via tax deed, and 11 WHEREAS, during the time period beginning January 1, 1986 through January 1, 1997, 12 values were set on the premise that the parcel could be developed as a single family residence, and 13 14 WHEREAS, during these years the requirements of the zoning precluded such 15 16 development, and 17 WHEREAS, not recognizing these restrictions constitutes a manifest clerical error, and 18 19 WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.45.500 (c) allows a governing body to correct manifest 20 clerical errors at any time, and 21 22 WHEREAS, the amount of error for the tax years involved totals \$3,186.15 23 24 NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves: 25 26 Section 1. That the taxes assessed for the listed parcel be reduced by \$3,186.15. Of that amount, 27 that \$2,109.95 of overpaid taxes plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment on 28 that amount be properly distributed. 29 30 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the 31 Anchorage Municipal Assembly. 32
