## ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AR NO. 99-<u>311</u>

## A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOMMENDING REGULATING THE LEVEL OF CHENEY LAKE TO PROTECT PUBLIC AND PRIVATE INFRASTRUCTURE

WHEREAS, Cheney Lake is an attractive, usable body of water that is home to various species of birds and fish as well as a pleasant site for recreation by Anchorage residents; and

WHEREAS, Cheney Lake was a gravel pit that has become a man-make lake filled by stormwater runoff and springs, which no longer has an outlet and consequently has a rising water level; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has constructed substantial roadway, drainage and parks improvements based on the historic 207-foot lake elevation; and

WHEREAS, the existing roadway is subject to frequent flooding, frost heaves and pavement failure; and

WHEREAS, the existing storm drain outfalling into the lake is submerged which results in inadequate capacity during periods of high rainfall and, further, is blocked with ice during Spring breakup; and

WHEREAS, the storm drain outfalls into Cheney Lake without treatmant of pollutants; and

WHEREAS, the current lake level results in erosion of the lakeshore adjacent to the existing pathway; and

WHEREAS, the park benches, trees and other landscaping are frequently submerged; and

WHEREAS, administrative staff of the Municipality has determined through thorough and extensive engineering studies that in order to make Baxter Road and Beaver Place safer and more passable, and to reduce maintenance, the level of Cheney Lake should be lowered three feet; and

WHEREAS, ongoing notice was given through numerous meetings, newsletters and mail outs, and through numerous consultations with local residents affected by this project, and through thorough consideration of viable alternative solutions; the Municipality has already commenced repairs of the two roadways and related facilities in such a way that will not cause permanent environmental, recreational, and aesthetic degradation to the lake and surrounding residential areas; and

WHEREAS, alternative means of accomplishing the roadway improvements and facilitating safe and efficient use of nearby roads and reducing groundwater infiltration cannot be implemented without lowering the level of Cheney Lake; and

WHEREAS, the project plan has been reviewed by numerous Federal, state and local agencies and necessary approvals and permits have been acquired.

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<u>Section 4.</u> That the Municipality shall increase public involvement in Phase 2 of the project and seek consultation on pathways, landscaping, traffic calming and other amenities.
