A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING ARLENE PATTON

WHEREAS, Arlene Patton has served the State of Alaska and the community of Anchorage for more than 15 years in her various roles with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, Arlene Patton has been instrumental in so many efforts to further affordable housing and community development issues, to include:

Her creation and leadership of the Alaska Affordable Housing Partnership, which earned a HUD Best Practices Award. This Partnership brought an enormous and divergent group of organizations from across the State involved in supporting and creating affordable housing to one table to share successes and challenges so that others might learn from them, and so that organizations could pull together to make needed changes in regulations, conditions, and attitudes on affordable housing;

Her tireless work to help create the Anchorage Weed and Seed Program and to lead the Weed and Seed's Neighborhood Revitalization Subcommittee;

Her advocacy for Habitat for Humanity, and her effort to secure properties in Anchorage upon which Habitat could construct affordable homes, as well as her labor to build Habitat's Women's House;

Her efforts to inform and support the Municipality's Housing and Community Development Block Division and the Housing and Neighborhood Development Commission, and to enable Anchorage to compete in the Empowerment Zone application. The application resulted in the Municipality receiving a designation of Strategic Planning Community; and

WHEREAS, Arlene Patton has led the effort to promote and encourage partnering among communities, neighborhoods, nonprofits and for-profits, government agencies, and private citizens - she has been committed to resolving problems in a professional manner and has made huge strides in restoring the public's trust in government.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves to recognize and honor

who has been a strong advocate within HUD for the needs of Alaska and Alaskans.
