AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE SECTION 6/CAMPBELL AIRSTRIP ROAD LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 4, 2000 A BALLOT PROPOSITION APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF SAID LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF THREE YEARS. ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 27.20.210 AND 27.30.300.

WHEREAS THE Section 6/Campbell Airstrip Road Limited Road Service Area was created by Anchorage Ordinance 82-28; and

WHEREAS a showing of interest in continuing said limited road service beyond December 31, 2000 has been made by persons residing in said limited road service area; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Section 6/Campbell Airstrip Road Limited Road Service Area at the regular Municipal election on April 4, 2000:

CONTINUATION OF THE  
SECTION 6/CAMPBELL AIRSTRIP ROAD LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA

Shall the existence of the Section 6/Campbell Airstrip Road Limited Road Service area be continued for an additional period of three (3) years after December 31, 2000 until December 31, 2003?

4 Section 2. That Section 27.20.210 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to  
5 read as follows:

7 Pursuant to section 27.10.050, there is established a board of supervisors to  
8 administer the Section 6/Campbell Airstrip Road Limited Road Service Area. The board  
9 shall consist of five members appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the assembly to  
10 administer the service area until the regular election of October 1982, at which time the  
11 supervisors will be elected for staggered terms. Initial terms of supervisors elected at the  
12 regular election of October 1982 shall be selected by lot. [THE SERVICE AREA WILL  
13 EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2000, UNLESS IT IS EXTENDED BY VOTE IN THE AREA  
14 AFFECTED AT THE REGULAR ELECTION OF APRIL 2000.]

17 Section 3. That Section 27.30.300 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby  
18 amended to read as follows:

20 There is established a limited road service area within the municipality known as  
21 Section 6/Campbell Airstrip Road Limited Road Service Area to provide limited road  
22 maintenance and repair to the area described on the map located in section 27.30.700.  
23 Limited road maintenance and repair within the service area shall commence on January 1,  
24 1982, and shall end on December 31, [2000] 2003, unless the service area is extended by  
25 an affirmative vote of the area affected at the regular election in April [2000] 2003. The mill  
26 rate shall not exceed 1.0 mill in any calendar year.

29 Section 4. Except for Section 3, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and  
30 approval. Section 3 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon  
31 certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if  
32 that proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
