AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE BEAR VALLEY LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 4, 2000 A BALLOT PROPOSITION APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF SAID LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF THREE YEARS. ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 27.20.290 AND 27.30.370.

WHEREAS THE Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area was created by Anchorage Ordinance 88-99; and

WHEREAS a showing of interest in continuing said limited road service beyond December 31, 2000 has been made by persons residing in said limited road service area; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area at the regular Municipal election on April 4, 2000:

CONTINUATION OF THE BEAR VALLEY LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA

Shall the existence of the Bear Valley Limited Road Service area be continued for an additional period of three (3) years after December 31, 2000 until December 31, 2003?

Section 2. That Section 27.20.290 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Pursuant to section 27.10.050, there is established a board of supervisors to administer the Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area (BVLRSA. The board shall consist of three members appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the assembly to administer the service area until the regular election of October 1989, at which time the supervisors will be elected for staggered terms. Initial terms of supervisors elected at the regular election of October 1989 shall be elected by lot. [THE SERVICE AREA WILL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2000, UNLESS IT IS EXTENDED BY VOTE IN THE AREA AFFECTED AT THE REGULAR ELECTION OF APRIL 2000.]

Section 3. That Section 27.30.370 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is established, pursuant to section 9.01 of the Charter, a limited road service area within the municipality to be the Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area of the municipality, as outlined on the map located in section 27.30.700. The Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area shall contribute funds expressly for the maintenance of roads and snow plowing, commencing January 1, 1989 and shall end on December 31, [2000] 2003 unless the service area is extended by an affirmative vote of the area affected at the regular election of April [2000] 2003. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.50 mills in any calendar year.

<u>Section 4</u>. Except for Section 3, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval. Section 3 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
