AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE SEQUOIA ESTATES LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 4, 2000 A BALLOT PROPOSITION APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF SAID LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF THREE YEARS. ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 27.20.300 AND 27.30.380.

WHEREAS THE Sequoia Estates Limited Road Service Area was created by Anchorage Ordinance 88-93; and

WHEREAS a showing of interest in continuing said limited road service beyond December 31, 2000 has been made by persons residing in said limited road service area; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Sequoia Estates Limited Road Service Area at the regular Municipal election on April 4, 2000:

CONTINUATION OF THE
SEQUOIA ESTATES LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA

Shall the existence of the Sequoia Estates Limited Road Service area be continued for an additional period of three (3) years after December 31, 2000 until December 31, 2003?

4 Section 2. That Section 27.20.300 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to
5 read as follows:

7 Pursuant to section 27.10.050, there is established a board of supervisors to
8 administer the Sequoia Estates Limited Road Service Area (SELRSA). The board shall
9 consist of five members appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the assembly to
10 administer the service area until the regular election of October 1989, at which time the
11 supervisors will be elected for staggered terms. Initial terms of supervisors elected at the
12 regular election of October 1989 shall be elected by lot. [THE SERVICE AREA WILL
13 EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2000, UNLESS IT IS EXTENDED BY VOTE IN THE AREA
14 AFFECTED AT THE REGULAR ELECTION OF APRIL 2000.]

16 Section 3. That Section 27.30.380 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to
17 read as follows:
18

19 There is established, pursuant to section 9.01 of the Charter, a limited road service
20 area within the municipality to be the Sequoia Estates Limited Road Service Area of the
21 municipality, as outlined on the map located in section 27.30.700. The Sequoia Estates
22 Limited Road Service Area shall contribute funds expressly for the maintenance of roads
23 and drainage, and for street lighting, commencing January 1, 1989, and shall end on
24 December 31, [2000] 2003, unless the service area is extended by an affirmative vote of
25 the area affected at the regular election of April [2000] 2003. The mill rate shall not exceed
26 1.50 mills in any calendar year.

29 Section 4. Except for Section 3, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and
30 approval. Section 3 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon
31 certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if
32 that proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
