AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 23, SECTION 23.10.102.9.F.1.d OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE AND PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE IN THE USE OF UNIT HEATERS THAT COMPLY WITH AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARDS INSTITUTE TO BE USED IN MOBILE AIRCRAFT SHELTERS .

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Anchorage Municipal Code Title 23, Section 23.10.102.9.F.1.d is hereby amended to read as follows:

23.10.102.9 Mobile Aircraft Shelters

F. *Heating Methods.* Heating mobile aircraft shelters may be provided as follows:

- 1 The following may be used as methods of heating authorized aircraft, vehicle, equipment or shelters:
 - a. No change
 - b. No change
 - c. No change
 - d. sealed combustion unit heaters designed and manufactured in accordance with the American National Standards Institute definition of separated combustion. Such heaters shall be listed by an approved listing agency, and shall be installed and operated in conformity with their listing and all applicable codes. The heaters shall be located near the rear of the hangar, as high as possible, and as far as possible from the aircraft fuel tanks and engine. The fuel source shall be natural gas. [FORCED AIR SEALED COMBUSTION CHAMBER HEATERS USING OUTSIDE COMBUSTION AIR CONNECTED TO NATURAL GAS PROVIDED SUCH HEATERS ARE UL APPROVED AND ARE DESIGNED, INSTALLED AND OPERATED IN CONFORMITY WITH APPLICABLE BUILDING AND FIRE CODES.]

(The remainder of this section is not affected by this ordinance and is therefore not set out.)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
