AN ORDINANCE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE PROVISION 1.15.170 TO REQUIRE DISCLOSURE OF FINANCIAL INTEREST BY CERTAIN MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the Ethics Code of the Municipality of Anchorage provides the ethical foundations by which municipal officials and municipal employees conduct the business of government; and

WHEREAS, the Ethics Code should provide for a procedure by which management employees disclose any financial interest in any administrative/quasijudicial determination of a Municipal board or Commission.

## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Anchorage Municipal Code 1.15.170 is hereby amended to read as follows:

15.170 Requirements for elected officials [.] , certain municipal employees, members of regulatory, appellate and quasijudicials boards and commissions.

G. Municipal employee disclosure. Any municipal employee who serves as Municipal Manager, Executive Manager, a Department Director, a Utility General Manager, or a Division Manager shall disclose in writing any financial interest in any project or property that may come before any board or commission of the Municipality of Anchorage for any action. Such disclosure shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk upon employment or upon subsequently acquiring the financial interest.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
