AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING
ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 10.20.040, EXEMPTING FEDERALLY-
LICENSED WHOLESALE AND RETAIL GUN DEALERS FROM THE
MUNICIPALITY'S SECONDHAND MERCHANT'S LICENSE REQUIREMENT

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That AMC 10.20.040 A. is amended to read as follows:

License Required. No person may do business as a secondhand merchant within the municipality without first obtaining a secondhand merchant's license from the municipal clerk. A specific location for the conduct of the business shall be designated on the license. As used in this section, the term "secondhand merchant" means any person **other than a federally-licensed wholesale or retail gun dealer** who engages in the regular business of buying used personal property within the municipality for cash, money order or other negotiable instrument, and reselling that property to the public.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval.
