As used in this section, the term "secondhand merchant" means any person who engages in the regular business of buying used personal property within the municipality for cash, money order or other negotiable instrument, and reselling that property to the public, except for wholesale or retail firearms dealers licensed by the United States Department of Treasury, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms, only with respect to the purchase and sale of firearms as defined in the Gun Control Act of 1988, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44.
